Thieme MedOne Clinical Capsules: Endocrine Search within Clinical Capsules: Endocrine System **Pathogenesis** A distinction is made between osteoporosis with increased (high turnover) and with reduced bone remodeling (low turnover). The former is mainly characteristic of postmenopausal osteoporosis, the latter of senile osteoporosis. The loss of bone mass is particularly noticeable in the trabecular structures of the cancellous bone, which leads to reduced load-bearing capacity and, due to the altered bone strength, reduced bone density which leads to increased tendency to fracture. The vertebral fractures that occur result in deformed vertebral bodies, so-called wedge, fish, and flat vertebrae
